SAEPU supports COSATU's call with regard to the removal of Minister Aaron Motsoaledi by president Cyril Ramaphosa.

The South African Emergency Personnel's Union (Saepu) fully supports Cosatu's call for the removal of Minister Aaron Motsoaledi as the Health Minister by President Cyril Rmaphosa in order to save the country's failing Health system.
